#### Management Approach

## Safety, Occupational Health, and Working Environment Committee

. The Committee is required to maintain at least 50% representation from employees at the operational level out of all committee members (excluding the committee chair), and must meet at least once a month and has the following duties:

## Roles of the Safety, Occupational Health and Working Environment Committee

- Review policies and work plans for Safety, Occupational Health, and Working Environment in the workplace.
- Set prioritization and integration of action plans in line with Safety, Occupational Health, and Working Environment goals.
- Suggest for improvement and report on the progress of performance to reduce and prevent related risks on the safety in the work of employees, contractors and outsiders who come to work or come to use the service in the company.
- Promote and support safety activities in the workplace, including following up, reporting and evaluation.
- Conduct safety walk through survey (auditing) in the workplace and examine statistics on accidents that occur in place of the company at least once a month.
